## WHAT DOES "EQUINE" MEAN?

noun: a horse; adjective: of, relating to, or resembling a horse

The word "equine" has the same root as the word "equitation," which is the art of riding a horse. An equine veterinarian is a horse doctor., and an equine medical center or clinic is a horse hospital.

## HOW TALL IS THAT HORSE?

A horse's height is measured from the ground to the withers, in 4 -inch units called "hands." The number of whole hands is followed by a period and the remaining height in inches. So a horse who measures 5 feet and 2 inches is 15.2 hands ( $1^{\prime}=12^{\prime \prime}$ so $5^{\prime}=60^{\prime \prime} \div 4=15$ hands).


Any horse measuring less than 14.2 hands is a pony. Samson, born in 1846, was the tallest horse ever, at $21.21 / 2$ hands. Can you figure
 out how much that is in feet and inches?
